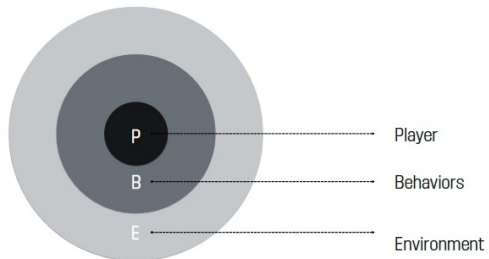

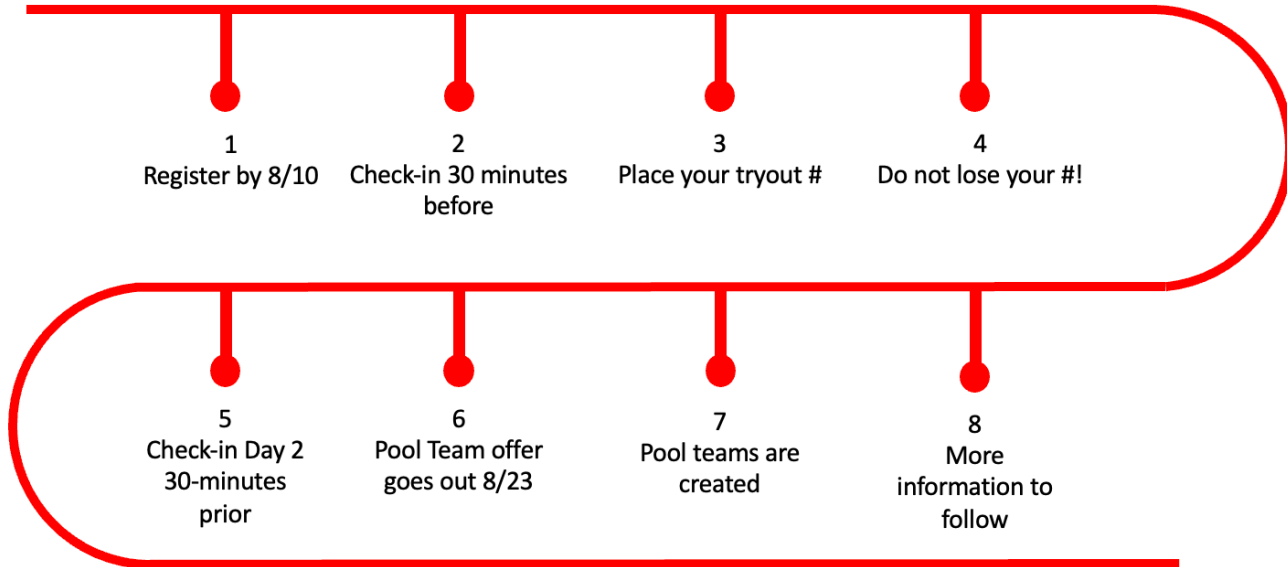
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- Tryout/Evaluation Process (Operations)



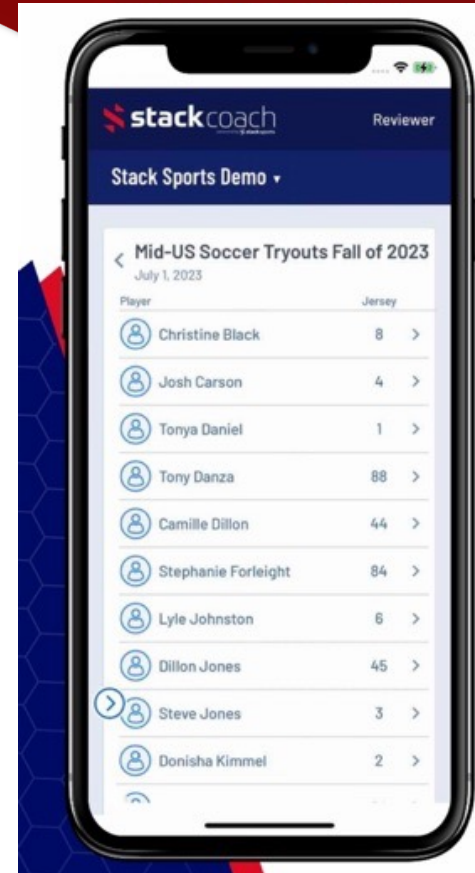
TRYOUT PROCESS TIMELINE
